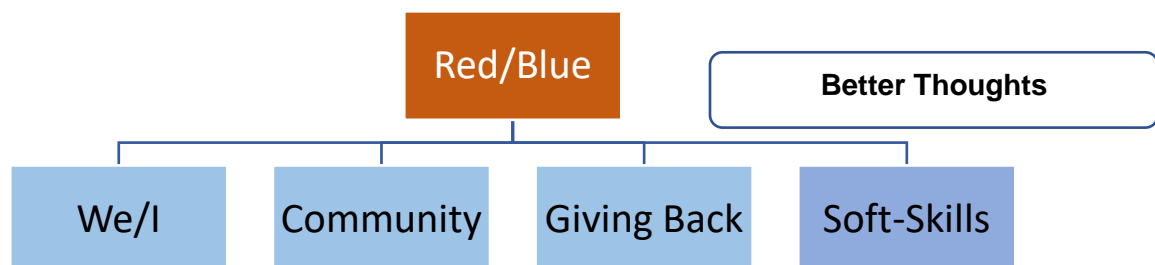
How should politicians model better working and listening to the other side when working on country problems?
